What it is

It is a Bible Study curriculum with the goal to help students get “the big picture” when they look into God’s Word. That means creating a complete curriculum that covers the entire Bible.

This plan will accomplish two purposes in the life of a teenager. The first is that they’ll receive real guidance for living like Christ during their formative years. The second is that when they graduate high school, they’ll do so with a greater, more confident knowledge of God’s amazing message.
